2. Can I apply for more than one type of grant?

Because of the varying qualifications, only the following combinations may be applied at the same time:

- College scholarship and EXCEL Entrance
- Anniversary Grant and EXCEL Entrance

There is only one type of grant for SHS.

Note that applicant may only avail of one grant.

3. What are the other types of discounts?

4. How do I apply for scholarship?

Download the applicable application form available in the website. Complete instructions are indicated in the first sheet. Make sure to read thoroughly and follow the instructions indicated.



5. When is the deadline of application?

Deadline of application for the College and SHS Scholarship and Anniversary Grant is on June 15, 2021.

There is no deadline for EXCEL Entrance application. However, note that only the first 100 qualified applicants may be given discount. Announcement shall be made once the limit has been reached.

6. Can current students apply for scholarship?

Priority for the scholarship slots are incoming SHS and college students. Slots for current students may be opened if a current scholar has been disqualified from his/her grant. Slot availability will be based on the course/strand and year level/grade vacated. The Student Welfare and Development Department shall make the necessary announcement if a slot for current student was opened.

7. How are scholars selected?

Applicants are initially screened based on the documents submitted. Shortlisted applicants (ratio of number of applicants vs number of available slots) will then undergo interview.

Selection is based on a number of factors – applicant's academic performance, leadership and extra-curricular engagement, family need/income, scholarship benefactors' preferred course, and interview performance.

8. I met the grade and income qualifications, will my application be approved?

Not automatically. The qualifications indicated in the scholarship application form are minimum requirements. Note that, historically, applicants far outnumber the scholarship slots available. Hence, the rigorous selection process.

For Anniversary Grant and EXCEL Entrance, applications are processed on a first-come, first-served basis.

9. The deadline of application is on June 15, 2021 but my graduation is later than that. How do I submit my grades?

For scholarship application, grade card requirement is only

SHS - Grade 9 and up to second grading period of Grade 10
College - Grade 11 and up to second grading period of Grade 12

These should be available by now. Third and fourth grading periods of Grade 10 and Grade 12 are NOT required.



10. I have some documents already. Can I submit partial requirements?

Scholarship applicants are advised to submit the accomplished application form and documentary requirements in one email so it will be easier to keep track of the application. Applications will be reviewed fairly regardless of the date of submission, provided within the given period.

Email size limit is 20 MB. If documents exceed this, applicant may upload via Google Drive.

11. How soon before we know the results?

The result will be tentatively released within a month after deadline of submission. This will depend on the number of applicants to be assessed.

12. Because of quarantine restrictions, I cannot process/complete the other documents needed. What do I do?

For SY 2021-2022, the checklist of requirements has been reviewed to ensure that only the most necessary documents are needed.

Parents of applicants are advised to check with the necessary offices, e.g. Human Resources, BIR, Barangay, etc. if required document may be availed online. For face-to-face transactions, parents/applicants are advised to ensure that government's safety protocols are complied with.

It is necessary for the Selection Committee to have comprehensive picture of the profile of the applicant to be able to assess the most deserving students.
